Last year we had almost 40 vendors – let's try for 50 this year!

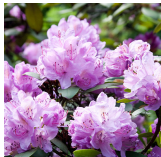
→ Baking is needed for the **Bake Table** – please start baking ahead and freezing it until the Big Day!
